WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Auckland Printing Trades Apprenticeship Committee has made application to the Court for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Printing Trades apprenticeship order, dated the 18th day of October, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 1102, as amended by an order dated the 1st day of September, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 774: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said apprenticeship order, as amended by the order dated the 1st day of September, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 774, shall be further amended by striking out clause 10 thereof, and substituting the following clause therefor:----

"10. The minimum rates of wages payable to apprentices shall be— Per Week.
