

(10743.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) RETAIL SHOP ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Retail Shop Assistants' award, dated the 9th day of April, 1934, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIV, p. 160.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties to the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Retail Shop Assistants' award, dated the 9th day of April, 1934, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIV, p. 160, which application was filed herein on the 13th day of September, 1934; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following subclause to clause 23 thereof:—

“(c) This award shall be read subject to the provisions of section 3 (2) and section 5 of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
