

(10886.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT DAIRY FACTORY MANAGERS.—AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913.

WHEREAS the Agreement made between the New Zealand Dairy Factory Managers' Association (as such association and as acting on behalf of the dairy factory managers of the Wellington Industrial District) and the Wellington Industrial Union of Dairy Factory Employers expired on the 31st July, 1935: And whereas the parties to the agreement have met and considered the terms and conditions of the schedule filed with the Clerk of Awards at Wellington, it is hereby agreed that the schedule hereinbefore referred to and the copy of which is attached hereto marked "A" is renewed for the period from 31st July, 1935, until 31st December, 1935.

That on or before the above date the tribunal shall meet to decide whether the present scale shall continue for a further fixed period or whether there is a case warranting at the date of such meeting for a restoration of a portion of cuts made in the schedule.
