

(10747.) AUCKLAND (TEN-MILES RADIUS) HAIRDRESSERS' ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Ten-miles Radius) Hairdressers' Assistants' award, dated the 5th day of September, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 804.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Auckland (Ten-miles Radius) Hairdressers' Assistants' award, dated the 5th day of September, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 804, which application was filed herein on the 24th day of January, 1935; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from clause 3 (a) thereof the figures and symbols "£4 5s.", and substituting therefor the figures and symbols "£4 10s."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect as from the 4th day of February, 1935.
