

(11239.) FACTORIES AMENDMENT ACT, 1936.—ORDER EXTENDING WORKING-HOURS IN RESPECT OF N.Z. MILK PRODUCTS, LIMITED, INVERCARGILL.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Factories Amendment Act, 1936; and in the matter of an application by N.Z. Milk Products, Ltd., Invercargill, for an extension of the limits of working-hours prescribed by section 3 (1) of the said Act.

Monday, the 2nd day of November, 1936.

UPON reading the application by N.Z. Milk Products, Ltd., Invercargill, for an extension of the limits of working-hours prescribed by section 3 (1) of the Factories Amendment Act, 1936, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said company and the workers concerned, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3 (5) of the said Act, and with the consent of the said representatives, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the maximum number of hours (exclusive of overtime) to be worked in any week between 15th September and 15th June inclusive in the factory occupied by the applicant company shall be fixed at 44.

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of August, 1937.
