

(11019.) NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, NELSON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Painters and Decorators' award, dated the 3rd day of April, 1935, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXV, p. 427.

Wednesday, the 25th day of March, 1936.

UPON reading the application to add a party made by the Auckland Painters, Decorators, and Leadlight Workers' Industrial Union of Workers, party to the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Nelson, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Painters and Decorators' award, dated the 3rd day of April, 1935, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXV, p. 427, which application was filed herein on the 15th day of October,

1935, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the undermentioned company, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That Sanford Ltd., Jellicoe Street, Auckland, C. 1, be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award subject to the following special condition:

“That nothing in the said award shall apply to members of the factory staff employed on a weekly wage and temporarily transferred to painting-work on the employer’s ships.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
