

**(11349.) WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT HAWKE'S BAY) SHOP-ASSISTANTS, WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BUTCHERS, AND WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT RETAIL GROCERY WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARDS.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments, and in the matter of (a) the Wellington Industrial District (except Hawke's Bay) Shop-assistants' award, dated the 21st day of December, 1934, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIV, p. 754, made in an industrial dispute between A. W. Allen, Ltd., and others, and the Wellington Amalgamated Society of Shop-assistants in the Boot, Hardware, Stationery, Fancy-goods, Furniture, and Soft-goods' Industrial Union of Workers; (b) the Wellington Operative Butchers' award, dated the 2nd day of October, 1933, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXIII, p. 963, made in an industrial dispute between G. A. Bannin and others, and the Wellington Operative Butchers' Industrial Union of Workers; and (c) the Wellington Industrial District Retail Grocery Workers' award, dated the 26th day of September, 1935, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXV, p. 955, made in an industrial dispute between the Wellington Grocers' Industrial Union of Employers, and others, and the Wellington Grocers' Assistants' Industrial Union of Workers, and the Wellington Retail Grocers' Shop-managers' Industrial Union of Workers; and in the matter of an application under section 21 of the said Act for adjustment of the terms of the said awards.

UPON hearing the application filed herein on the 15th day of October, 1936, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the applicants, and it appearing that the industrial unions of workers above named have been amalgamated and a new industrial union registered under the name of the Wellington Amalgamated Society of Shop-assistants (other than Hairdressers' Assistants) Industrial Union of Workers, pursuant to section 21 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, now, therefore, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by the said section, doth hereby order that the said awards be and they are hereby amended by substituting the name of the last-mentioned union for the names of the amalgamated unions hereinbefore referred to.
