

(11077.) OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND ENGINE-DRIVERS, FIREMEN,
AND GREASERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' award, dated the 17th day of December, 1935, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXV, p. 1403.

Friday, the 29th day of May, 1936.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Otago and Southland Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' award, dated the 17th day of December, 1935, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXV, p. 1403, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award be and it is hereby amended—

(a) By striking out from subclause (f) of clause 6 thereof the figure "9", and substituting therefor the figure "7":

(b) By striking out from subclause (c) of clause 7 thereof the figures "6" and "7", and substituting therefor the figures "11" and "12" respectively:

(c) By striking out from subclause (a) of clause 8 thereof the figure "9", and substituting therefor the figure "7".

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
