## NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT WESTLAND) FREEZING WORKERS.— DECISION OF CONFERENCE OF PARTIES VARYING AWARD.

THE Hon. the Minister of Labour having directed that the rates of remuneration to hourly workers employed under the terms of the New Zealand (except Westland) Freezing-workers' award dated the 30th November, 1936, be increased, it is hereby agreed that, as between the persons, firms, and companies cited as parties to such award and the North Island Freezing-works and Related Trades Industrial Association of Workers, the South Island Freezing-works and Related Trades Industrial Association of Workers, the Wellington Freezing-works and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers, the Nelson Freezing-works Employees' Industrial Union of Workers, the Auckland Abattoir Assistants and United Freezing-works Employees' Industrial Union of Workers, and the Otago and Southland Freezing-works and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers that we accede to the Minister's direction, and that, as from the 1st day of January, 1937, a bonus of 3d. per hour shall be paid to all workers who are employed on an hourly basis in addition to the rates prescribed by section 2 of the above award. Such bonus shall be paid for all time actually worked. The rate of bonus paid in respect of overtime shall be 3d. per hour as in the case of ordinary time.
