CHRISTCHURCH (TEN-MILES RADIUS) MOTION-PICTURE PROJECTIONISTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Christchurch (Ten-miles' Radius) Motion-picture Projectionists' award, dated the 5th day of February, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 42.

Wednesday, the 4th day of August, 1937.

Upon reading the application of the Christchurch Motion-picture Projectionists' Industrial Union of Workers for amendment of the Christchurch (Ten-miles' Radius) Motion-picture Projectionists' award, dated the 5th day of February, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 42, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and of the employers concerned, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 21 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1936, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended—
- (a) By fixing at forty the maximum number of hours (exclusive of overtime) that may be worked in any week by any worker bound by the said award; and
- (b) By adjusting the rates of pay prevailing on the day of the date hereof so that the ordinary rates of weekly wages of any worker shall not be reduced by reason of the reduction made in the number of working-hours.
- 2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
