## DUNEDIN TRAMWAY AND OMNIBUS EMPLOYEES.—VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREMENT.

In the matter of the industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, dated the 16th day of February, 1937, between the Dunedin City Corporation (hereafter called "the employer"), of the one part, and the Dunedin Tramways' Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") of the other part.

## REVIEW OF WAGES.

Whereas it is provided in clause 1 of the said industrial agreement that "the wages-rates herein contained are subject to review after the 31st March, 1937, and any increases that may be agreed upon after such review shall date retrospectively from 1st April, 1937": And whereas, in pursuance of the foregoing provision, it is hereby mutually agreed between the employer and the union that all the wages-rates prescribed in clause 1 of

the said agreement shall be increased by 1d. per hour, and that the said increase shall be payable as from the 1st day of April, 1937.
