

WELLINGTON (TWENTY-FIVE MILES RADIUS) TIMBER-YARDS, SAWMILLS, AND BOX-FACTORIES EMPLOYEES.—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington (Twenty-five Miles Radius) Timber-yards, Sawmills, and Box-factories Employees' award, dated the 21st day of December, 1936.

UPON reading the application of the Wellington Timber-yards and Sawmills Industrial Union of Workers, a party to the Wellington (Twenty-five Miles Radius) Timber-yards, Sawmills, and Box-factories Employees' award, dated the 21st day of December, 1936, to add the Wellington Harbour Board, Wellington, as a party to the said award, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and the Wellington Harbour Board, this Court doth order as follows:—

- (1) That the Wellington Harbour Board, Wellington, be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award, subject to the qualification that it may substitute the holidays observed under its by-laws for the holidays specified in the said award.
- (2) That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
