DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES' DRIVERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of an application under section 21 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1936, by the Otago Drivers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers for amendment of the Dunedin Local Bodies Drivers' Award, dated the 5th day of November, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 982.

Friday, the 12th day of March, 1937.

Upon reading the application of the Otago Drivers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers for amendment of the Dunedin Local Bodies Drivers' Award, dated the 5th day of November, 1926, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVI, p. 982; and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the union and employers concerned this Court, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section 21 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act, 1936, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended as follows:—

(a) The maximum number of hours (exclusive of overtime) that may be worked in any week by any worker bound by the said award shall be forty.

(b) Drivers employed at scavengering and street cleaning may be worked from Monday to Saturday morning

inclusive.

(c) Other workers may be worked from Monday to Friday inclusive.

- (d) The rates of pay shall be adjusted in accordance with subsection (3) of section 21 of the said Act, so that the ordinary rates of weekly pay of any worker shall not be reduced by reason of the reduction made in the number of working-hours.
- 2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
