

**NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT FRUIT-PRESERVING AND
VEGETABLE-CANNING EMPLOYEES.—ADDING PARTIES TO
AWARD.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Fruit-preserving and Vegetable-canning Employees' award, dated the 29th day of September, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 875.

UPON reading the application to add parties made by the union of workers party to the Northern Industrial District Fruit-preserving and Vegetable-canning Employees' award, dated the

29th day of September, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 875, which application was filed herein on the 17th day of February, 1938, and upon hearing the duly appointed representative of the said union and such of the persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named as appeared either in person or by their representatives duly appointed, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That C. H. Furness and Co., Ltd., 56 Bassett Road, Remuera, Auckland, S.E. 2, and G. E. Winson, Baking-powder Manufacturer, Brighton Building, Fanshawe Street, Auckland, C. 1, be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award.

2. That W. F. Tucker and Co., corner Khyber Pass and Auburn Street, Auckland, C. 3, be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award subject to the following special condition:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in subclause (c) of clause 12 of the said award, W. F. Tucker and Co. may continue to employ any youth employed on the 1st day of March, 1938, but no additional youths may be engaged in excess of the number allowed under the said subclause.

3. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
