

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **AERATED-WATER**  
**WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Aerated-water Workers' award, dated the 25th day of February, 1938.

Thursday, the 12th day of May, 1938.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on the Court by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Northern Industrial District Aerated-water Workers' award, dated the 25th day of February, 1938, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out subclause (a) of clause 3 thereof, and substituting the following subclause therefor:—

“(a) Youths may be employed at the following rates of pay:—

“ For the fourth six months .. ..	1	17	6
“ For the third year .. ..	2	5	0
“ For the fourth year .. ..	2	15	0
“ For the fifth year .. ..	3	5	0

“ Provided, however, that a worker twenty-one years of age or upwards shall be paid in accordance with clause 2.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
