

NEW ZEALAND FREEZING COMPANIES' **CLERICAL WORKERS.**—
ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Freezing Companies' Clerical Employees' award, dated the 20th day of September, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 1941.
