

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **DENTAL TECHNICIANS.**—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Dental Technicians' apprenticeship order, dated the 8th day of March, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 822.

Tuesday, 21st day of June, 1938.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the mechanical dentistry industry in the Wellington Industrial District has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Dental Technicians' apprenticeship order, dated the 8th day of March, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 822: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by adding the following paragraph to clause 2 thereof:—

“This order shall apply to both male and female apprentices.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
