

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **L I M E - W O R K E R S .**—
EXTENDING SCOPE OF AND ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Lime-workers' award, dated the 29th day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 3094.

UPON reading the applications to extend the scope of the Wellington Industrial District Lime-workers' award, dated the 29th day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 3094, and to add parties thereto, which applications were made by the union of workers party to the

said award, and were filed herein on the 10th day of March, 1938, and the 25th day of March, 1938, respectively, and upon being satisfied that due notice of the said applications has been given to the union, persons, firms, and companies hereinafter named, and that no written notice of opposition to the said applications has been received by the Clerk of Awards within the time notified, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the scope of the said award be and it is hereby extended so as to include the Taranaki and Nelson Industrial Districts.

2. That the undermentioned union, persons, firms, and companies be and they are hereby added as parties to the said award:—
