

NEW PLYMOUTH **TRAMWAYS AND OMNIBUS EMPLOYEES.**—  
VARIATION OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT.

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments, this 25th day of May, 1938, between the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of New Plymouth (hereinafter, together with the Council of the said borough, termed “the employer”), of the one part, and the New Plymouth Municipal Tramways and Omnibus Employees’ Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter termed “the union”), of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the employer and the union that the industrial agreement made in pursuance of the said Act and its amendments between the employer and the union, dated the 18th day of March, 1935 (hereinafter termed “the said agreement”), shall be varied by the addition to the said agreement, after clause 14 thereof, of the following clause:—

“14A. It shall be competent for any worker who agrees in writing with the secretary of the union so to do to accept any wage other than that specified in this agreement for such period as may be arranged between the parties.”
