

**NELSON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BUILDERS, CONTRACTORS,
AND GENERAL LABOURERS, AND KILN-WORKERS.—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers' award, dated the 9th day of November, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2284; and in the matter of the Nelson Industrial District Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers', and Kiln-workers' award, dated the 24th day of May, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 1265.

Thursday, the 23rd day of June, 1938.

WHEREAS on the 30th day of March, 1938, the Wellington Labourers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers and the Nelson Labourers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers amalgamated to form one union: And whereas there were in force on the said 30th day of March, 1938, the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers' award, to which the Wellington Labourers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers was a party, and the Nelson Industrial District Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers', and Kiln-workers' award, to which the Nelson Labourers' and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers was a party: And whereas the New Zealand Federated Labourers' and Related Trades Industrial Association

of Workers, a party to one of the said awards, has made application for an order adjusting the terms of the said awards: And whereas the prescribed notice of the said application has been given to the parties concerned: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 21 (2) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said awards shall be adjusted by substituting the rates of wages and conditions of employment prescribed in the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers' award for those prescribed in the Nelson Industrial District Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers', and Kiln-workers' award, but otherwise the provisions of the Nelson Industrial District Builders', Contractors', and General Labourers', and Kiln-workers' award shall remain in full force and effect.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
