

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON (TWENTY-FIVE-MILE RADIUS), WESTLAND, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **CLERICAL WORKERS.**—ORDER GRANTING TOTAL EXEMPTION FROM AWARD.
