AUCKLAND GAS COMPANY'S CLERICAL AND SHOWROOM EMPLOYEES.—VARIATION OF AGREEMENT.

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, between the Auckland Gas Co.'s Clerical and Showroom Employees' Industrial Union of Workers, of the one part, and the Auckland Gas Co., Ltd., of the other part, witnesseth that the aforesaid parties hereby agree that the agreement dated the 12th day of November, 1937, shall be amended by adding the following subclause, viz.:—

Clause 4 (e): "The employer may make a rateable deduction from the weekly wages prescribed for any time lost by the worker through sickness, accident, or his or her default."
