

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **ELECTRICAL WORKERS.**—  
STRIKING OUT PARTIES FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Workers' award, dated the 1st day of June, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 1323.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Workers'

award, dated the 1st day of June, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 1323, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and by section 89 of the said Act as amended by section 5 (4) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act (No. 2), 1937, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—
