NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PAINTERS AND DECORATORS.—AMENDMENT OF APRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Painters' and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 809.

Whereas by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the painting and decorating industry in the Northern Industrial District has made application to the Court for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Painters' and Decorators' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of August, 1924, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXV, p. 809; Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by striking out from clause (2) thereof the words "and leadlight working."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
