NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, NELSON, WESTLAND, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND RETAIL GROCERS' ASSISTANTS AND DRIVERS.—EXEMPTION FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Retail Grocers' Assistants' and Drivers' award, dated the 6th day of August, 1938; and in the matter of an application by the Sanitarium Health Food Co. for exemption from the said award.
