

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON (TWENTY-FIVE-MILE RADIUS), WESTLAND, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **CLERICAL WORKERS.**—EXEMPTIONS FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington (Twenty-five-mile Radius), Westland, and Otago and Southland Clerical Workers' award, dated the 14th day of July, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 1585; and in the matter of an application by the Auckland Laundry, Ltd., and others for partial exemption from the said award.

JUDGMENT OF J. A. GILMOUR, S.M., ACTING AS A DULY APPOINTED DELEGATE OF THE COURT OF ARBITRATION.

THIS is an application by the Auckland Laundry, Ltd., and other laundry and dry-cleaning establishments for exemption from the Northern, Wellington (Twenty-five-mile Radius), Westland, and Otago and Southland Clerical Workers' award, dated the 14th day of July, 1938, in respect of laundry-depot workers.

I am satisfied from the evidence presented at the hearing that the work performed by these workers does not bring them within the scope of the Clerical Workers' award.

An order is accordingly made under section 89 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, as amended by section 5 (4) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Amendment Act (No. 2), 1937, granting exemption from the provisions of the said award to the undermentioned employers in respect of laundry-depot workers:—

Auckland Laundry, Ltd., The New, Surrey Crescent, Auckland, W. 2.

N.Z. Dry Cleaning Co., Ltd., 3 Howe Street, Auckland, C. 2.

Porters' Dye-works, Ltd., 135 Karangahape Road, Auckland, C. 2.

Supply Laundry and "Tri" Cleaners, Ltd., 67 Victoria Street, Auckland, C. 1.
