

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT WESTLAND) **STOREMEN AND
PACKERS.**—STRIKING OUT PARTY FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Westland) Storemen and Packers' award, dated the 31st day of January, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 212.

Tuesday, the 25th day of October, 1938.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand (except Westland) Storemen and Packers' award, dated the 31st day of January, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 212, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the list of parties thereto the name of—
