1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (f) of clause 4 thereof and substituting the following subclause therefor:—
"(f) Shift-workers: Workers employed on shifts shall be paid

9d. per shift extra."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect as from the 29th day of June, 1937.
