

**WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT FIBROUS PLASTERERS.—  
EXTENDING SCOPE OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTIES.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Fibrous Plasterers' award, dated the 30th day of July, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 2000.
