

AUCKLAND (TWELVE-MILE RADIUS) **MOTOR ENGINEERS.**—  
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland (Twelve-mile Radius) Motor Engineers' apprenticeship order, dated the 23rd day of March, 1925, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVA, p. 196.

Wednesday, the 26th day of October, 1938.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in connection with the motor-engineering industry in the Northern Industrial District has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Auckland (Twelve-mile Radius) apprenticeship order, dated the 23rd day of March, 1925, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXVA, p. 196: Now, therefore, the duly appointed Delegate of the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in the Court by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by striking out clause 1 thereof and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ 1. The locality in which this order shall have effect is the Northern Industrial District.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
