

NORTH CANTERBURY TIMBER-YARDS, SAWMILLS, AND COAL-YARDS EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTIES.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the North Canterbury Timber-yards, Sawmills, and Coal-yards Employees' award, dated the 22nd day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2989.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the North Canterbury Timber-yards, Sawmills, and Coal-yards Employees' award, dated the 22nd day of December, 1937, and recorded in

Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2989, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the parties, this Court, by its duly appointed delegate, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following subclause to clause 5 thereof:—

“(c) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages to be paid to men employed in country sawmills:—
