

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **ELECTRICAL SUPPLY
AUTHORITIES' EMPLOYEES.**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Supply Authorities' Employees' award, dated the 14th day of October, 1938.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Supply Authorities' Employees' award, dated the 14th day of October, 1938, this Court, by its duly appointed delegate, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by inserting the words “apparatus or appliances” after the words “electrical equipment” in subclause (f) of clause 1 thereof.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
