

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **RACECOURSE EMPLOYEES.**—EXTENDING SCOPE OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTIES.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District, Racecourse Employees' award, dated the 9th day of May, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 949.

UPON reading the application to extend the scope of the Wellington Industrial District Racecourse Employees' award, dated the 9th day of May, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 949, and to add parties thereto, which application was made by the Wellington Racing Club, party to the said award, and was filed herein on the 15th day of June, 1938, and upon being satisfied that due notice of the said application has been given to the clubs hereinafter named, and that no written notice of opposition to the said application has been received by the Clerk of Awards within the time notified, this Court, by its duly appointed Delegate, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the scope of the said award be and it is hereby extended so as to include the Taranaki Industrial District.
