

**NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PLUMBERS AND
GASFITTERS.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Plumbers' and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 19th day of October, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 865.

Thursday, the 1st day of December, 1938.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee set up in

connection with the plumbing and gasfitting industry in the Northern Industrial District has made application to the Court for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Plumbers' and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 19th day of October, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 865 : Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That clause 17 of the said order shall be amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :—

“ No apprentice shall be permitted to work overtime unless he is under the constant supervision of a competent tradesman.”

2. That this order shall take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
