WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL LABOURERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington City Council Labourers' award, dated the 2nd day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2724.

Thursday, the 1st day of December, 1938.

Upon reading the joint application by the parties for amendment of the Wellington City Council Labourers' award, dated the 2nd day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2724, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said parties, this Court, in pursuance and

exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended by inserting the following provisions after clause 19 thereof:—
- "19a. The following special conditions of employment shall be applicable to the undermentioned resident caretakers of parks, and the head and assistant caretakers at Wainui-o-mata, Orongorongo, and Karori water reserves:—
 - "Clarke, G., Central Park.
 - "Rawlings, R., Golf-links.
 - "Glen, A., Onslow Reserve.
 - "McKay, Andrew, Otari Reserve.
 - "Heath, W., Kelburn Park.
 - "Stack, J., Karori Park.
 - "Wilkins, H., Kilbirnie Park.
 - "Sheldon, A., Anderson Park and Botanical Gardens.
 - " Head Caretaker, Wainui-o-mata.
 - "Head Caretaker, Orongorongo.
 - " Head Caretaker, Karori.
 - "Assistant Caretakers, Wainui-o-mata and Orongorongo.

" Hours of Work.

- "Forty hours shall constitute a week's work, with one whole day of twenty-four hours off without duties, except that in exceptional cases duties may be required to be performed, but should such duties exceed in time two hours on the whole-day holiday another day shall be given in lieu thereof.
- "In the case of duties being performed on the whole-day holiday and not exceeding two hours, such time shall for the purpose of calculating the weekly hours of employment be counted as two hours.
- "Notwithstanding the foregoing, the above-named are required to be available for duty in the case of any emergency, and a watch is expected to be kept on reserves, parks, or any property under custody.

" Annual Leave.

"On completion of each twelve months of continuous service, annual leave of absence of three weeks shall be granted with a payment of three weeks' ordinary wages. (This is to compensate for any duties that are usually performed on statutory holidays and other non-working days.)
