

NEW ZEALAND SHIPS' MASTERS AND OFFICERS (COASTAL SHIPPING COMPANIES).—ADDING PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925; and in the matter of the New Zealand Ships' Masters and Officers (Coastal Shipping Companies) award, dated the 4th day of October, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2084.

Thursday, the 24th day of February, 1938.

UPON reading the application to add a party made by the union of workers party to the New Zealand Ships' Masters and Officers (Coastal Shipping Companies) award, dated the 4th day of October, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2084, which application was filed herein on the 8th day of October, 1937, and upon hearing the duly appointed representatives of the said union and the under-mentioned company, this Court doth order as follows:—

(a) That the Colonial Sugar Refining Co., Ltd., be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award in respect of the master of its tug "Bulli," subject to the following special conditions—

- (1) The minimum rate of wages shall be £30 10s. per calendar month, less 5 per cent.
- (2) The sum of £4 per calendar month shall be paid to cover all overtime.
- (3) When the master is required to work overtime without having been notified on the previous day he shall be paid 1s. 6d. meal-money.
- (4) A fortnight's holiday on full pay shall be granted after the completion of twelve months' continuous service, and shall be taken at a time to be mutually arranged between the company and the master. Should the engagement be terminated except for wilful misconduct after six months but before the completion of twelve months' continuous service, the master shall receive a proportionate payment in lieu of the holiday.
- (5) One week's notice on either side shall be sufficient to terminate the engagement, provided that this shall not prevent the master from being summarily dismissed for wilful misconduct.
- (6) The provisions of the said award, except membership of the union (clause 17), shall not apply.

(b) That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
