OHINEMURI AND WAIHI GOLD-MINES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Ohinemuri and Waihi Gold-miners' award, dated the 10th day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2737.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Ohinemuri and Waihi Gold-miners' award, dated the 10th day of December, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2737, this Court being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 2 (a) of the said award shall be amended by inserting after the words and figures "Sluicers, 18s. 11d." the words and figures "Riggers and canvas workers, £1."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
