

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT WELLINGTON SEVENTY-MILE RADIUS) **BREWERS, BOTTLERS, BOTTLE-WASHERS, AND AERATED-WATER EMPLOYEES.**—
STRIKING OUT PARTY FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District (except Wellington Seventy-mile Radius) Brewers, Bottlers, Bottle-washers, and Aerated-water Employees' award, dated the 4th day of November, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 740.

Monday, the 7th day of March, 1938.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Wellington Industrial District (except Wellington Seventy-mile Radius) Brewers, Bottlers, Bottle-washers, and Aerated-water Employees' award, dated the 4th day of November, 1936, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVI, p. 740, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the list of parties thereto the name of—

Vidal and Sons, Wine-merchants, Avenue Road, Hastings.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
