

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ENGINE-DRIVERS (ON LAUNCHES, TUG-BOATS, AND SCOWS).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments, and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Engine-drivers' (on Launches, Tug-boats, and Scows) award, dated the 9th day of February, 1938.

Monday, the 14th day of March, 1938.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Northern Industrial District Engine-drivers' (on Launches, Tug-boats, and Scows) award, dated the 9th day of February, 1938, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by altering the date of expiry of its currency from the 9th day of February, 1939, to the 31st day of July, 1938.
2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
