

**WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT DRUG, CHEMICAL,
CONDIMENT, SAUCE, AND PICKLE WORKERS.—EXTENDING
SCOPE OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTY.**

UPON reading the application to extend the scope of the Wellington Industrial District Drug, Chemical, Condiment, Sauce, and Pickle Workers' award, dated the 11th day of April, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 813, and to add a party thereto, which application was made by the union of workers party to the said award, and was filed herein on the 28th day of November, 1938, and upon being satisfied that due notice of the said application has been given to the company hereinafter named, and that no written notice of opposition to
