

NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, WESTLAND,
CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **BAKERS
AND PASTRYCOOKS AND THEIR LABOURERS.**—STRIKING
OUT PARTY FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Bakers and Pastrycooks and their Labourers' award, dated the 10th day of August, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 2049.

Tuesday, the 28th day of March, 1939.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Bakers and Pastrycooks and their Labourers' award, dated the 10th day of August, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 2049, this Court, by its duly appointed Delegate, doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by striking out from the list of parties thereto the name of—

Farmers' Co-operative Meat Co., Wanganui.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
