

NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND  
OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **BOOT OPERATIVES**.—STRIKING  
OUT PARTY FROM AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Boot Operatives' award, dated the 23rd day of August, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 1668.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Boot Operatives' award, dated the 23rd day of August, 1937, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 1668, this Court, by its duly appointed Delegate, doth order as follows:—
