

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts Boatbuilders and Shipwrights' award, dated the 3rd day of June, 1938, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVIII, p. 1374.
