

WELLINGTON CLEANERS, CARETAKERS, AND LIFT
ATTENDANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Cleaners, Caretakers, and Lift Attendants' award, dated the 17th day of April, 1940 (and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XL, p. 369).

Monday, the 24th day of June, 1940.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Wellington Cleaners, Caretakers, and Lift Attendants' award, dated the 17th day of April, 1940, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by inserting the words "or cleaners" after the words "For lift attendants" in subclause (b) of clause 3 thereof.

2. That this order shall take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
