

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ELECTRICAL SUPPLY
AUTHORITIES' EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Supply Authorities' Employees' award, dated the 13th day of February, 1940, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. XL, p. 42.

Monday, the 22nd day of April, 1940.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Wellington Industrial District Electrical Supply Authorities' Employees' award, dated the 13th day of February, 1940, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by adding the following subclause to clause 17 thereof:—

“(c) The employers shall notify the union of the engagement of new men covered by this award within fourteen days of their engagement.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
