

**MARLBOROUGH PLUMBERS AND GASFITTERS.—AMENDMENT
OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Marlborough Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Marlborough Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 21st day of September, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1416.

Monday, the 6th day of July, 1942.

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas application has been made to the Court for an amendment of the Marlborough Plumbers and Gasfitters' apprenticeship order, dated the 21st September, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1416: And whereas the Court has heard the representatives of the employers and workers bound by the said order: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by striking out from clause 17 (b) the words "Except in the case of an apprentice who has served five years".

2. That this order shall operate as from the day of the date hereof.
