

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **TOBACCO-WORKERS.**—
EXTENDING SCOPE OF AWARD AND ADDING PARTY.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Tobacco-workers' award, dated the 16th day of October, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1414.

UPON reading the application to extend the scope of the Wellington Industrial District Tobacco-workers' award, dated the 16th day of October, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1414, and add a party thereto, which application was

made by the union of workers, a party to the said award, and was filed herein on the 19th day of March, 1942, and upon being satisfied that due notice of the said application has been given to the company hereinafter named, and that no written notice of opposition to the said application has been received by the Clerk of Awards within the time notified, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (b) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the scope of the said award be and it is hereby extended so as to include the Northern Industrial District.

2. That the undermentioned company be and it is hereby added as a party to the said award:—

3. That this order shall operate as from the day of the date hereof.
