

**DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES' LABOURERS.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD AND ADDING PARTY**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Dunedin Local Bodies' Labourers award, dated the 27th day of August, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 911.

Thursday, the 16th day of December, 1943

UPON reading the applications made by the Dunedin City Council, a party to the Dunedin Local Bodies' Labourers' award, dated the 27th day of August, 1942, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by sections 92 (1) (c) and 94 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties and of the undermentioned union of workers, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award is hereby amended by adding to clause 2 thereof the following subclause:—

“(r) Men employed as licensed drainers shall be paid 2½d. per hour in addition to the rates of wages hereinbefore prescribed: Provided that when employed in cleaning blocked foul drains, or in working at old drains connected with a foul sewer, an additional payment of 2s. 6d. per day shall be made.”

2. That the Dunedin and Suburban Operative Licensed Drainers' Industrial Union of Workers is hereby added as a party to the said award, as from the day of the date hereof.
