- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for approval of the supplementary agreement, made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, on the 17th day

of May, 1943, between the Guild of Aeronautical Engineers of New Zealand, Incorporated, and the Union Airways of New Zealand, Ltd., and others.

Upon reading the application pursuant to Regulation 39 of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942 for approval of the supplementary agreement made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, on the 17th day of May, 1943, between the Guild of Aeronautical Engineers of New Zealand and the Union Airways of New Zealand, Ltd., and others, and upon reading the written submissions of the duly appointed representatives of the said guild and of the said company, and upon being satisfied that the said supplementary agreement is for the purpose of adjusting an anomaly, this Court, being of opinion that the said anomaly should be adjusted, having regard to the general purpose of the said regulations, doth hereby approve of the said supplementary agreement for the purposes of the said regulations.

New Zealand Aircraft Companies' Engineers' Assistants and Attendants.—Supplementary Agreement under Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913

This agreement, made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, this 17th day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three, between the Guild of Aeronautical Engineers of New Zealand, Incorporated (hereinafter called "the guild"), of the one part, and Union Airways of New Zealand, Ltd., Wellington, and others (hereinafter called "the employers"), of the other part, supplementary to an agreement made between the same parties bearing date the 21st day of September, 1942, and filed with the Clerk of Awards at Wellington on the 19th day of November, 1942 (42 Book of Awards 1288), (hereinafter referred to as "the principal agreement"), witnesseth that for the purposes of removing an anomaly which has become apparent in the principal agreement it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the parties that the schedule of minimum weekly rates of wages payable to engineers' assistants pursuant to clause 4 of the principal agreement shall be and the same is hereby cancelled, and in lieu thereof the rates of pay set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby adopted and shall come into effect on the date on which this supplementary agreement is filed with the Clerk of Awards at Wellington pursuant to section 8 (1) of the said Act, and it is hereby declared that the rates of wages hereinafter prescribed include all cost-ofliving bonuses heretofore granted to employees by general order or otherwise.
