NEW ZEALAND TIMBER-WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Timber-workers' award, dated the 1st day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 961.

Wednesday, the 17th day of February, 1943

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying defects in the New Zealand Timber-workers' award, dated the 1st day of September, 1942, this Court doth order that the said award is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) By inserting, after the word "mill" in subclause (c) of clause 2, the words "or factory".

(2) By inserting, after the words "average hours" in subclause (f), of clause 2, the word "worked".

(3) By inserting, after the words "constituted within" in

clause 17, the words "two months of".

(4) By inserting, after the word "secretary" in sub-

clause (b) of clause 23, the words "or branch secretary".

(5) By deleting the words "president or" in subclause (c)-of clause 23, and substituting therefor the words "secretary or branch".

(6) By inserting, after the word "duty" in subclause (d) of clause 23, the words "of the secretary or branch secretary".

This order shall take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
